

Prize Money:

Schurman Industrial Supplies and Toshi Imai Plumbing and Heating have generously offered to once again sponsor Wednesday nights this season. Thank you very much. There will be a total prize pool of \$1000 awarded at the end of the season.

Rules:

Unless otherwise specified, Berwick Curling Club league and bonspiel play is governed by the Curling Canada Rules of Curling. https://www.curling.ca/files/2022/08/Rule-Book-2022_General-Play_ENG_CC.pdf These include the new no-tick rule that was introduced last year.

Draw Times:

Two draws, beginning at 6:30 pm and 8:45 pm.

- No extra ends permitted.
- No end may start past 8:25 pm on the early draw or 10:40 pm on the late draw. It does not matter if there are empty sheets available afterwards, adhere to the time allotment.

Results:

- Immediately after the game, it is the responsibility of the winning team's Vice to record the results on the tablet at the bar. (W = win / T = tie / L = loss)

Spares:

- Each team must have at least two of the registered teammates playing in the game.
- If a team has a fifth listed on their start of the season roster, that person is not considered a spare, and can play any position
- A BCC member can spare as much as they want, with any team they want
- Spares who are not BCC members are capped at 5 games, \$15 per game.
- If you use one spare, they must play lead.
- If you use two spares, they must play lead and second.
- If you do not have at least two registered teammates playing, then that game will be forfeited, and the opposing team will receive the win. The only exception to this rule is if a team cannot field two registered teammates because they are competing at a provincial, national or world sanctioned curling event/playdown. In this case, that team must work with their opponents to find another date to play the game before the end of that round-robin's schedule.

League Format:

Teams will play a round-robin schedule and then be seeded into A and B divisions. The top 8 teams will be seeded in Division A and the remaining teams in Division B. A second round-robin within each Division will be played and play-off seedings will be determined from the results of the second round-robin. If a draw needs to be cancelled because of weather or ice conditions, that draw will be moved to the end of the round-robin schedule.

Tie Breakers:

If teams tie in points after a round-robin, the tie will be broken in the following manner:

1. Head-to-head record in that round-robin between the teams that are tied.
2. A measured draw to the button, with sweepers, by one team member. This must be done at the conclusion of your last game of each round-robin.
